RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. The Show will open at 9.00 a.m.
- 2. Dogs will be received at any time but it is the exhibitors responsibility to ensure that exhibits are available for judging when required.
- Judging will commence at 9.30 a.m.
- 4. Exhibits may be removed from the Show after their judging has been completed. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed.
- ENTRY FEES: £6.00 First Entry per Dog, £2.00p subsequent entries for SAME DOG. NFC £1.00 each dog. Membership Fees: Joint £5.00, Single £4.00, Prepaid Catalogues ONLY £3.50 to be collected by 11.00 a.m. after which they may be resold.
- 6. **PRIZE MÓNEÝ:** Prize money will be awarded in the Janet Boulton Memorial Puppy Stakes, 1st £10; 2nd £5; 3rd £3 and Reserve £2.0, and also where donated.
- 7. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
- 8. Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition.
- 9. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
- 10. **BEST PUPPY IN SHOW:** Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and has been declared Best Puppy in Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified Puppy or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register Puppy. A Puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best of Breed, Best in Group or Best in Show is a Puppy it may, at the discretion of the judge be awarded Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Where the Reserve Best of Breed, Reserve Best of Group or Reserve Best in Show is a Puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it may, at the discretion of the judge be Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group & Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best of Breed, Best of Group & Best in Show respectively.

Best Puppy in Group and subsequent Group placings must be selected from:

- a) Those puppies declared Best Puppy in Breed.
- b) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group or on each day.
- c) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Imported Breed Register classes in each group or on each day.

Best Puppy in Show must be selected from the Best Puppy in Group winners.

- 11. **BEST IN SHOW**: The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and has been declared Best of Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register.
 - a) Shows Judged On The Group System: (Definition; Shows judged on the Group System includes classes for breeds within more than one Group, as defined in the Kennel Club Regulations B(A); and require a judge to declare a best of each group after which the exhibits so declared will compete for the award of Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show).
 - 1) Best of Breed: Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed may be declared but only from those dogs which have received a first prize in a breed class at the show. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be declared.
 - 2) Best of Group Best of Group and subsequent placings must be selected from:
 - a) The Best of Breed winners in each Group.
 - b) The Best dog from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group or on each day.
 - c) The best dog from Any Variety Imported Breed Register classes in each Group or on each day.

 3) Best in Show: Best in Show must be selected from the Best of Group winners. Reserve Best in Show must
 - be selected from the remaining Group winners of Group winners of the selection for Best in Show.
- Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably been delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with a special permission of the Show Management.
 Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them nor handle a dog in a manner which
- 13. Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them nor handle a dog in a manner which causes its feet not touch the ground when on the move. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.
- All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
- 15. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
- the exhibitor/competitor

 16. DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS. Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licenced events.

When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.

- If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
- The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
- Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
- When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
- Keep the dog in the shade take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
- Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths
 of time

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.

- 17. Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any show licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the show.
- 18. Not for competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered.
- 19. No modifications will be made to the schedule except by permission of the Board of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine press wherever possible.
- 20. The show will be held under kennel club rules and regulations. All dogs must be registered with the Kennel Club, and where a change of ownership has taken place, the transfer must be made previously to the show.
- 21. Exhibitors passes will not be sent out, but each exhibitor will be allowed free admission to the show. If receipt of entry is required, please enclose a stamped self addressed envelope with your entry.
- 22. In all cases the decision of the judge is final, except where fraud, misrepresentation or breach of the rules is discovered or a bona-fide mistake is made by the judge.
- 23. Should a judge be prevented from fulfilling his/her engagement, the committee reserves the right to themselves to appoint another in his/her place. Exhibitors are at liberty to withdraw their dogs from competition, but no entry fee will be refunded.
- 24. The committee reserve to themselves the right on responsible grounds, to refuse any entries that they may think fit, to exclude any dog not in a fit state for exhibition from disease, savage disposition, vice or anyhow. If other causes (vide Rule 15)
- 25. Any objection to a dog must be made under Kennel Club Rule 28.
- No animal other than a dog entering at this show will be allowed within the precincts of the show during its continuation.
- 27. All persons making an entry or entries at this show shall be deemed to have agreed to abide by Kennel Club rules and regulations and by the show regulations of the committee. It is on this understanding only that entries are received.
- 28. The attracting of exhibits by any means from outside the ring is prohibited. It is the duty of the judge, steward, or show management, noticing such attractions to ask it to cease.
- 29. Any instructions in the nature of the rules and regulations printed for convenience in other parts of this schedule shall by receipt of entry be deemed to be the show regulations of the committee and shall have the same effect as if they had formed a part of these regulations.
- 30. Any owner, exhibitor, handler or other persons in charge of a dog is required to remove immediately any fouling caused by their dog(s) and/or any grooming waste at any Kennel Club licensed show within the licensed venue and within the environs of that event including car and caravan parks and approaches adequate receptacles for the disposal of such fouling and waste will be provided.

SECURITY AT SHOWS

In light of recent events the Kennel Club would like to issue a reminder to all societies of the importance of security at dog shows. The Kennel Club understand that due to the nature of dog shows and the quantity of paraphernalia exhibitors bring, it would be extremely difficult for show organisers to take on the issue of security alone, therefore we would re-iterated the advice being given by the Police and security services, that everyone in the UK should remain vigilant and this applies to those organising and taking part in dog shows.

The importance of exhibitors feeling that they and their dogs are safe when attending a show cannot be underestimated. We would therefore remind you of the importance of the need for show organisers and exhibitors to remain mindful of potential dangers and that all visitors to shows generally need to be vigilant and alert. Furthermore the society provide robust notification informing exhibitors of where to report to should they see anything suspicious or of concern, and the evacuation procedures in place.

In view of the above, should you see anything suspicious or of concern, please alert the Show Manager, and/or the Show Secretary immediately. If it is a package or bag you are concerned about, please do NOT attempt to move it or examine it yourself.

Should it be necessary for the hall to be evacuated, please remember that evacuation should be carried out as speedily but as safely as possible, as in the case of a fire. It is important that you do not block the exit routes with cages or bags. Please follow any instructions given to you by the Show Management regarding evacuation procedures.
