

holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.

If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.

The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.

Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog. When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.

Keep the dog in the shade – take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.

Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.

17. Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered.
18. No modifications will be made to the schedule except by permission of the Board of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine press wherever possible.
19. The Committee will be most anxious for the care and safety of dog brought for exhibition and any property entrusted to them, but it must be distinctly understood that the committee will not be responsible for the loss, detention of or damage to any dog or other property whether arising from accident or other cause whatever or from any act or omission of themselves, their officers, agents, servants or others.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW:-

Leaving M4 at Junction 19 take M32 for Bristol. Leave M32 at Junction 1 signposted Kingswood/Downend. Down slip road to roundabout take first turning left proceed in middle lane to traffic lights. Straight ahead on at lights keeping in the left lane, at roundabout take first turning left (4174 ring road), straight ahead on first roundabout, at second roundabout take first left signposted Westerleigh/Crematorium. Go straight ahead at the next roundabout. Staying on this road you will go over the M4 and in approx. half a mile you will come to a crossroad this is signposted Henfield/Ram Hill but also a large brown sign BITTERWELL LAKE, turn left towards lake (Henfield Road), drive past rank of houses and then take the right fork (telephone box on the right) go approx. 200 yards there is a gateway with car park, hall and grass area this is Henfield Hall. For anyone who attended Seminar this is the same venue.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The show will open at 10.00 a.m.
- Dogs will be received until 12 noon and after which no dogs may be received except under exceptional and unforeseen circumstances and by special permission of the Show Management.
- Judging will commence at 11.00 a.m.**
- Exhibits may be removed from the Show after their judging has been completed. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed.
- ENTRY FEES:** 1st Entry per dog £5.00 Non Members £7.00 all additional entries with same dog £1.00. NFC entries free. Membership: £3.00 Single; £4.50 Joint per annum, plus £1 joining Fee. Membership application will not be accepted with entry.
- There will be no prize money awarded at this show.**
- The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
- Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the show are not eligible for exhibition.
- The mating of bitches within the precincts of the show is forbidden.
- Best Puppy in Show** Where a Best puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and received a first prize in a class at the same show. A Puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best in Show is a puppy it should automatically be awarded Best Puppy in Show. Where the Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it should also automatically be Best Puppy in Show. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best in Show. Reserve Best Puppy in Show must be selected from the Best opposite Sex puppy and the reserve Best of Sex puppy to the exhibit declared Best Puppy in Show.
- Best in Show** Best in Show must be selected from the exhibits declared Best of Sex but only if they have received a first prize in a class at the same show. If a Reserve Best in Show is to be selected, the eligible dogs are those declared Best Opposite Sex and the Reserve Best of Sex to the exhibit declared Best in Show. The dogs declared Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show must not compete in any subsequent competition. Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with permission of the Show Management.
- Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidable delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
- Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them nor handle a dog in a manner which causes its feet not touch the ground when on the move. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.
- All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) - Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
- All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
- DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS.** Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
